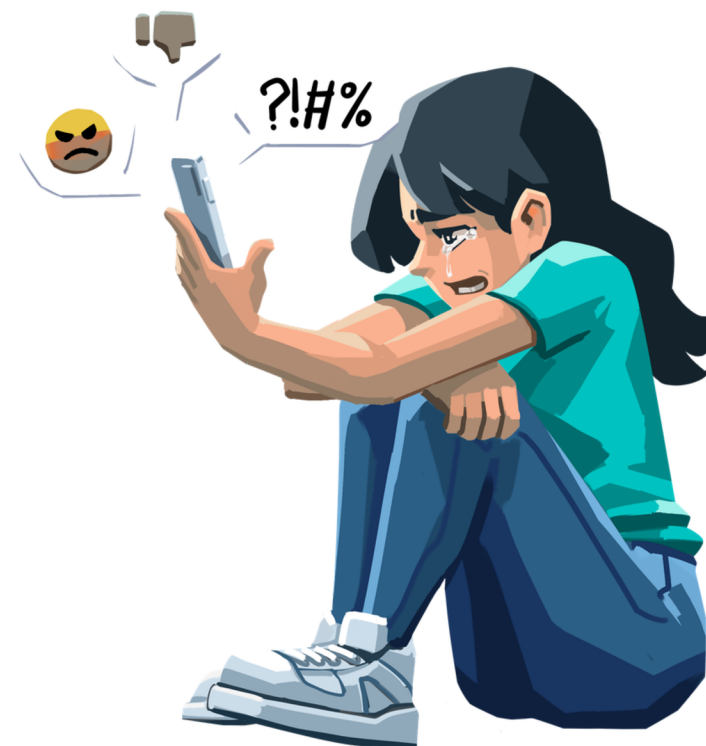

# Why CyberEqual?

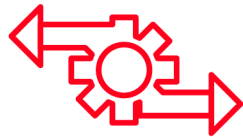
Cyber violence is a growing threat, especially for women and girls.
